Rules and Regulations

1. Exhibitors may enter as many exhibits as they wish
2. Junior and Secondary age groups may enter all classes
3. The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry
4. Entry cards will be supplied from 10.00am on the morning of the Show for the placing of exhibits
5. Every exhibit must be staged by 11.00 am and ready for judging at 11.30am, at which time the marquee will be cleared of all persons not officially engaged in the judging
6. All trays, dishes, plates, vases, boxes etc. for exhibiting flowers, vegetables etc. to be provided by the exhibitor
7. All exhibits shall be the recent and bona-fide property of the exhibitors and shall be grown, cultivated, created or made by the exhibitor
8. The stewards will take due care of all exhibits but will not be responsible for loss or damage
9. Moving or re-arranging the exhibits must be carried out by or under the jurisdiction of the Show manager
10. Objections must be lodged with the Show manager before the presentation of awards
11. Judges will use their discretion when judging, remembering the entries may come from inexperienced exhibitors
12. No exhibit may be removed from the hall until the completion of prize giving
13. If there is only 1 entry for a class, that will be placed into the miscellaneous category
14. All awards to be claimed on the day of the Show
